2009 NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT

The Nominating Committee met on Saturday, Oct 10, 2009, for the purpose of interviewing and proposing to the membership a slate of candidates to the NCTR Executive Committee.

The NCTR Constitution specifies that the position of President-Elect must be filled by a current member of the Executive Committee. The only nominee for this position was Ronnie Jung, Executive Director of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas and the current NCTR Secretary-Treasurer. The Nominating Committee unanimously agreed to propose the name of Ronnie Jung to the membership for the position of President-Elect.

The Nominating Committee then considered the candidates for the remaining two open positions on the Executive Committee. These positions are one (1) two year term and one (1) four year term on the Executive Committee. Seven (7) nominations were received by the Nominating Committee within the specified period.

The members of the Nominating Committee reviewed the NCTR Constitution, the policies of NCTR concerning nominations, the candidates nominating letters, and their previous involvement in NCTR activities.

After conducting interviews and evaluating all relevant factors, the Nominating Committee unanimously proposes the following slate of leaders to the membership:

For a Two Year Term on the Executive Committee, Tom Lee, Executive Director of New York State Teachers Retirement System.

For a Four Year Term on the Executive Committee, Leonard Bumbaca, Trustee from the Educational Employees' Supplementary Retirement System of Fairfax County.
